## Prize Fund Sharing

1. $40 \%$ of each participant's entry fee is fixed as a prize fund for the final session of the tournament.
2. Another $40 \%$ of entry fee is money for playing in preliminary session. This money is in disposal of each player during the preliminary competition in form of Game Points. Each Game Point is equivalent a money value.
3. The rest of entry fee ( $20 \%$ ) is fixed as a prize fund for the consolation - competition for the players, who are not qualified for the final session.

This entry fee will be shared between:
Preliminary session (money for Games Points), $€ \quad 20$
Prize fund of final session, $€ \quad 20$
Prize fund of consolation session, $€ \quad 10$

## Preliminary Session: FPP-Tournament ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ Competition

This tournament session is promoting like standard FPP-Tournament ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ to range the players and find the best of 8 .
Backgammon Fixed Play Parameters Tournament is promoted with fixed time and playing intervals, with known quantity of matches and games in each of matches.

By results of the preliminary session the best of 8 players are coming in the final session. The other players are playing in consolation session.

In case of several participants have the equal results in the bottom of the table the decision is taking under following conditions:

1. Match result(s) between given competitors are compared and the decision is determined on this (their) basis.
2. If the players did not play among themselves, then they should play an additional match and the winner takes place in the final session.

## Final and Consolations Sessions: Double Elimination <br> or <br> Knockout Competition

In final and consolation session it will be promoted double elimination or knockout tournaments till specific number of points depending on number of players and time in disposal of TD.
Double elimination competition could be 5 or 7 points match in winner and 3 or 5 points match in looser brackets.
Knockout competition will be 5 points match.
Prize fund will be shared between 2 best players in final and consolation sessions in follow proportion: $\mathbf{1 - 7 0 \%}, 2-30 \%$.
